David Crowe wins
German Grant for Journalism 2011

David Crowe, Chief Political Correspondent of the Australian Financial Review, has been awarded the German Grant for Journalism 2011.

David is a senior journalist who joined the Australian Financial Review in 1994. During his career he worked worldwide and was appointed Chief Political Correspondent in 2008.

The award is sponsored by the German Government and includes a two week journey to Germany in September 2011. Mr Crowe intends to get impressions of creativity and quality in Germany. German wine and of how Germans combine work and lifestyle will also be in his focus. For this purpose, he is going to visit various organisations including the German Wine Institute in Mainz, the Daimler Fuel Cell Development Centre in Stuttgart, Ceramic Fuel Cells Ltd. as well as the 'Great Place to Work Institute Germany' in Cologne.

The German Grant for Journalism has been awarded annually since 1986 and is thus celebrating its 25th anniversary this year. The applications are assessed by a joint panel nominated by the German Embassy and the National Press Club. The Chargé d'Affaires a.i. of Germany, Mr Matthias Sonn, presented the grant to David Crowe on August 17 at the National Press Club of Australia.
